

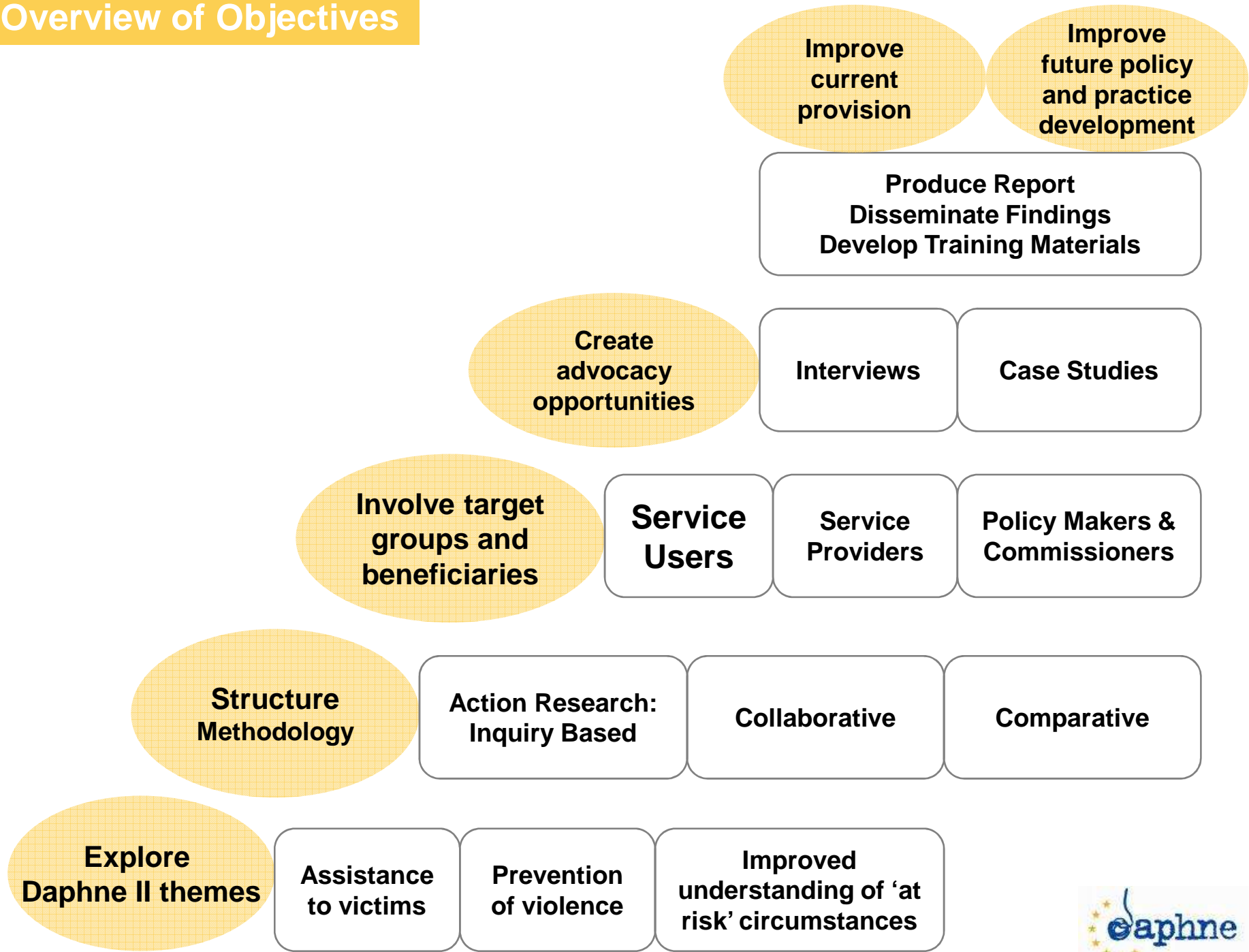

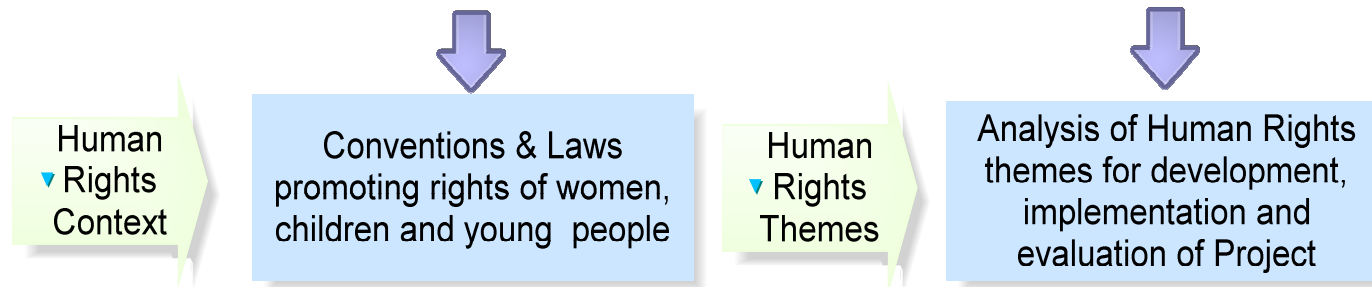

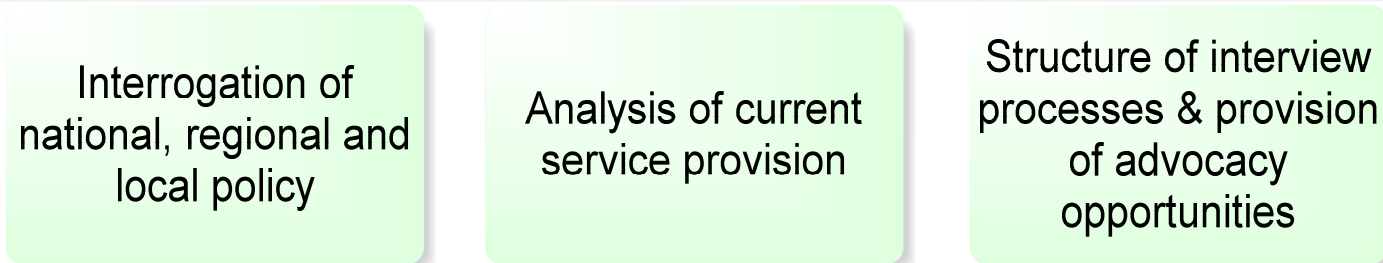

Analytical Framework



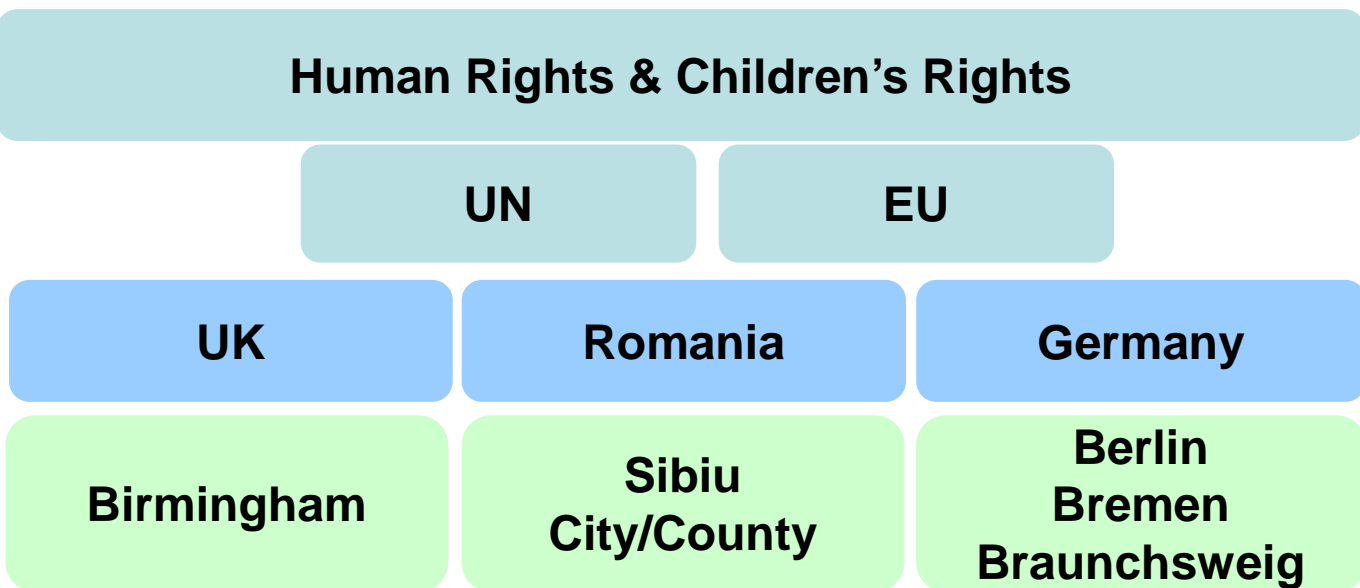
Top-down & bottom-up approach, Griffin (2008:29)

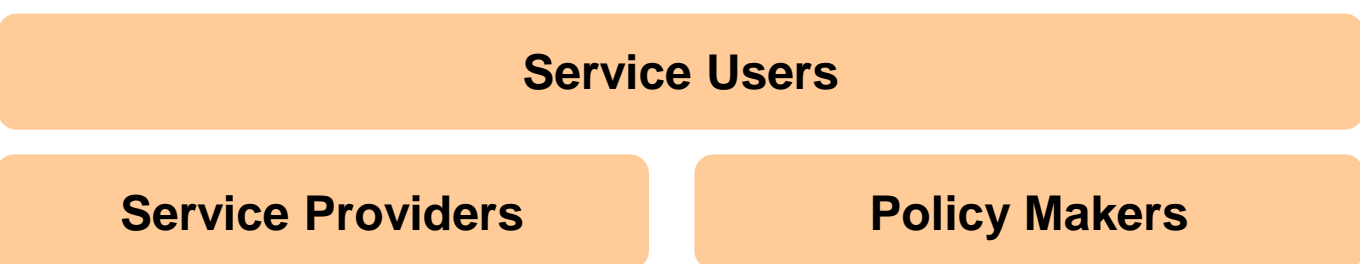

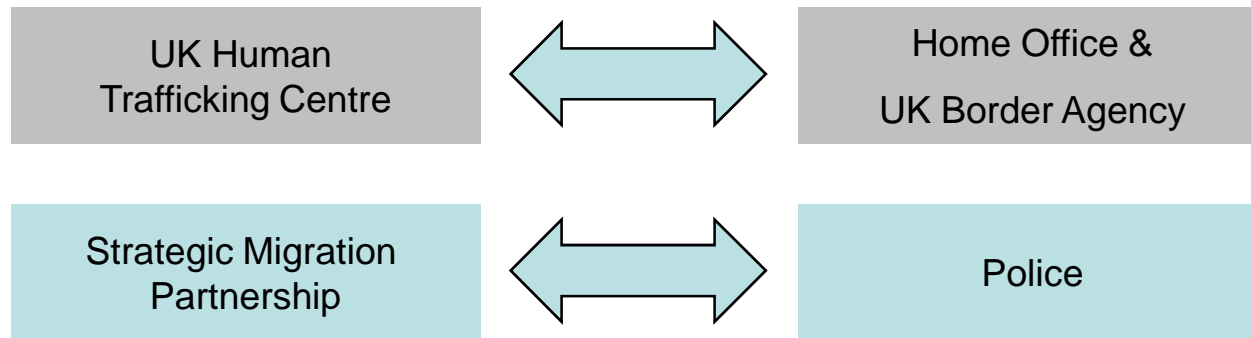
