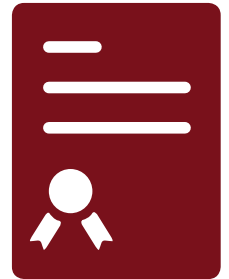

£21.5million has been spent on campus since 2015 upgrading and creating new teaching, study and accommodation facilities to enhance your learning and student life.

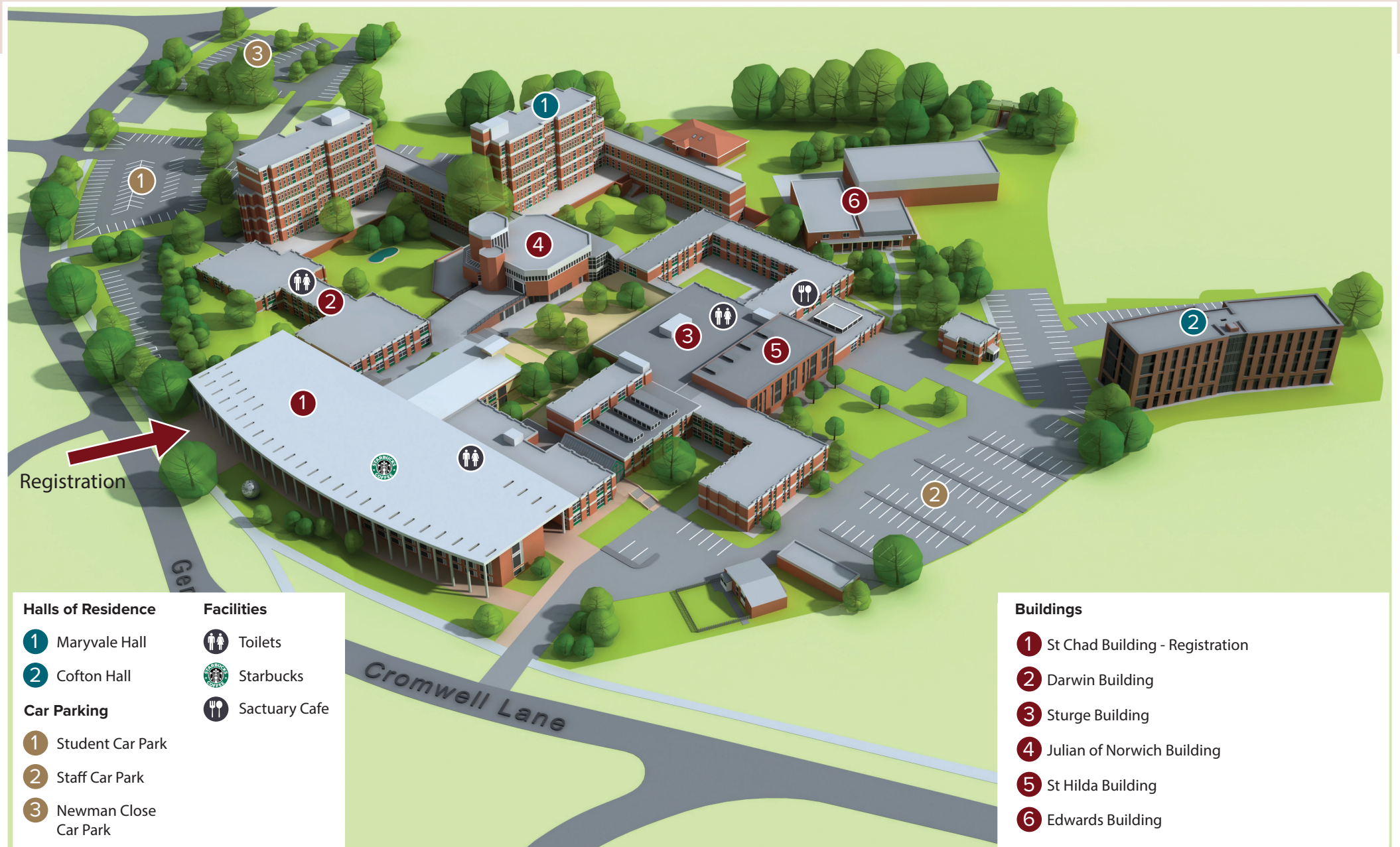
We have a range of accommodation options available from traditional Halls with shared kitchen and bathroom to deluxe en-suite accommodation.
