Counselling and Psychotherapy Training

OVERVIEW:

Full professional registration as a UKCP psychotherapeutic counsellor can be achieved by successful completion of the MSc, completing 450 hours supervised professional practice and 105 hours personal therapy (via the Certificate in Professional Practice). Professional registration as a UKCP psychotherapist can be achieved by successful completion of the MSc, the additional completion of the one-year Advanced Diploma in Psychotherapy Studies, a total of 450 hours supervised professional practice and 160 hours personal therapy (via the Certificate in Professional Practice).

Advanced Diploma in Psychotherapy Studies <i>(1 Yr P/T)</i>	MSc + Advanced Diploma provides academic taught component for registration as a Psychotherapist with UKCP.

**As part of the enrolment process for both the MSc and Advanced Diploma, you will be expected to enrol onto the Certificate in Professional Practice (CPP) at the same time. There is no additional cost for this programme during the taught programme, however, you will be required to pay one module based fee per year (e.g. £1100 for 2019/20) once you have completed your taught programme.*
