




## Birmingham Newman Direct How to Apply

If you wish to apply for school-based teacher training, you will apply via the Department of Education (DfE). Detailed below is the process for making your application.

**Step 1.** Visit the **Get into Teaching** website [getintoteaching.education.gov.uk](https://getintoteaching.education.gov.uk)


### Step 2.
